They also utilize Trimble Robotic Total Station to download our Cad layouts directly to the field.

He currently sits on the MCAA subcommittee for BIM implementation, and attends as many CAD and BIM forums as possible. A member of the National Academy of Building Sciences Building Smart Alliance, he regularly participates in monthly meetings of the Chicago area BIM group associated with the Building Smart Alliance.

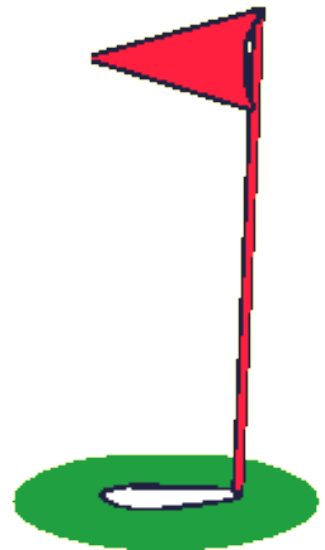
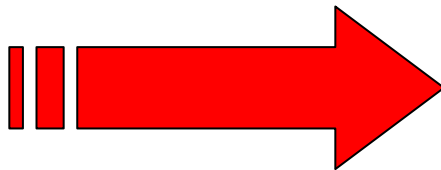

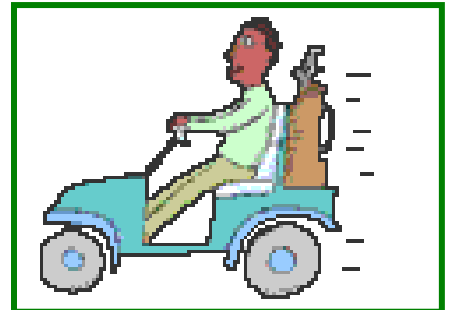
MPMCA Golf Reservation
