The Seminar will be conducted by MPMCA instructors/proctors Martin Jipson and Phyllis Centers both with 30 years of experience as licensed plumbers and ASSE certified Backflow testers.

Class Content:

Overview of the problem of cross connections. Review of case histories, causes, health hazards. Study of Department of Environmental Quality Rules, and Michigan Plumbing Code with regard to the protection of the Potable Water Supply. Review of American Society of Sanitary Engineering guide for the proper selection and use of backflow prevention devices. Description of the eight different ways to prevent cross-connections. Detailed study of backflow preventers. Class instruction will include the use of films, and review quizzes to reinforce the message of the instructor.

Hands-on experience with various backflow preventers. Students will learn how to spot problems and how to correct them. Instructor on hand to answer any or help solve any problems during the hands-on testing experience.

Detailed instruction on varieties of backflow preventers by factory representatives of the various manufacturers. Representatives from the following companies will conduct mini-seminars on the intricacies of testing and repairing their particular devices: Balfrey & Johnston (Zurn-Wilkins), Dave Watson Associates (WATTs, AMES & FEBCO), Mid-West Instrument (Test Equipment) Apollo Valve (APOLLO & CONBRACO).

This class requires applicants to have five years' experience in a plumbing, pipefitting, lawn irrigation, water purveyor, sprinkler installer, or related field. The instructor will begin the class at a level that requires all applicants to have basic knowledge of plumbing, hydraulics, etc. Licensed plumbers must provide their date of licensing and non-licensed applicants must provide a letter from their employer verifying at least 5 years' experience.

Final Examination of Proficiency Required for Certification

Under Act 54 - Plumbing Inspectors Registration Act - Plumbing Inspectors will receive 24 specialty and 16 technical CEU credits.

Water Purveyor Participants receive 3.2 continuing education credits (MDEQ Division of Drinking Water & Radiological Protection).

Who Should Attend:

The seminar is open to master and journey plumbers, plus others including lawn irrigation, sprinkler installers, and water purveyors, who have at least five years' experience in testing and need to test backflow preventers.

What You'll Get

Upon satisfactory completion, <u>Michigan licensed plumbers</u> receive a certification for general testing and are qualified to repair, replace, or install backflow devices. <u>However, licensed plumbers must provide</u> their license number and date of the license expiration. Licensed plumbers must have current license to be qualified to repair or replace backflow devices. If the license is expired the plumber is limited to testing backflow devices.

Other graduates who <u>are not licensed plumbers</u> receive certification and are limited to testing only. They are not permitted to install, replace, or make repairs to backflow devices. They must contact a licensed plumber according to Michigan State Law.

Complete the application form on the reverse side. The registration fee is \$1,020 for MPMCA members and \$1,270 for nonmembers, which covers the five days of instruction, examination materials, and testing kits for hands on portion. Be sure to bring something to write with. Each class is limited to 20 participants. Registration fee must accompany application form to be considered for acceptance.

Certified Testers will be listed on our website.

For a tester referral, you must provide us with a company name, address, phone number, and county.

If a company name is not provided, your listing will have your first name, last name, certification number, and plumbing license number listed.

Home addresses and home phone numbers are not listed on our website unless you let us know that is what you want for your listing.
